In this discussion, Giovanni will delve into the “science” and “tech” behind Generative AI tools drawing from his experience of working with natural language processing, computation linguistics and related fields. Huda, as a PhD scholar and an early-career researcher focusing on bodily autonomy, will discuss her lived experience of dealing (or not dealing) with these tools. Lastly, Aamir will describe the struggles of establishing ‘dos’ and ‘dons’ for students related to the use of these tools from within the context of a bioethics centre in Pakistan.

This panel discussion aims to deepen our understanding of the technology behind generative AI tools and to critically examine the ethical challenges they pose, particularly within higher education. Attendees will gain insights into the promises and pitfalls of these technologies, helping to foster informed discussions on their appropriate use in academia.
